Miss Celebrations USA defines beauty by what our Directors and Queens put their minds, hands and hearts to.

Nationals is the Leadership Teams way to award these Queens for all their hard work throughout the year to help those less fortunate!

OUR PURPOSE

As part of our basic entry fee, our Celebrations contestants are required to bring a donation of at least 10 nonperishable food items for the local charity in that community. I have a passion for feeding hungry children. It literally breaks my heart to think of children going to bed hungry. However, we will, on occasion, work with other non-profit organizations. (Veterans groups, women's shelters, etc.) We help wherever we are needed.

Miss Celebrations USA is a two-tier pageant system. (No State Pageants!) This means that once you have a Miss Celebrations USA title you are qualified for Nationals 2019 (Your Basic Entry fee is paid).

Cutting out the traditional "State Pageant" allows for more Celebration Pageants at a local level. Giving us more opportunities to help more people and touch more lives. We call our local pageants "Mini State" pageants. This makes it possible for contestants and Queens to participate in more pageants, while spending less (you are not limited in the number of Celebration titles that you hold.) Additionally, this system allows us to provide our Queens and families with more parties, prizes and fun.

Being a Queen is a privilege! It comes with serious perks and serious responsibilities:
